Aaron Patrick Architects is pleased to provide a proposal for professional services on the above referenced project. Our understanding of the scope of work and terms are documented and set forth in this proposal. We are currently working at Peabody Elementary and our consultant team for MEP has a thorough understanding of the facility, the condition, and the repairs needed as described below.

I. Project Description

Aaron Patrick Architects will provide professional design and consulting services necessary for the repair and renovation of Peabody Elementary. The scope of the work includes the following:

- Abatement of Existing Mold and Asbestos as needed throughout
 - APA will work directly with SCS to determine areas in need of remediation.
- Repair of upper floor decking and structural sleepers
- Removal of all Flooring and replacement with LVT and period appropriate LVT on upper floors
- Removal of failing paint and sealing of all efflorescence.
- Painting of all vertical surfaces throughout
- Replacement of ceiling grids in areas where unrepairable
- Replacement of existing ceiling tiles with humid resistance tile in areas subject to moisture
- Replacement of existing molded ductwork with like sized ductwork with outside insulation
- Alternate scope for exterior tuckpointing in areas subject to moisture and failing
- Alternate scope for replacement of failing or discolored window panes with low E insulated glass panes to match existing
- Alternate scope for LED lighting upgrade throughout school
- APA will work directly with CSA (mechanical and electrical consultants) for specifying and design of all HVAC and electrical upgrades.

II. Basic Scope of Services

Aaron Patrick Architects will provide the following as part of our basic scope of service:

- Oversight of Environmental Remediation
- Architectural Construction Documents
- Project Specifications
- Bidding Assistance/Contract Review
- Construction Administration
- Project Closeout

Review Phase

APA will review all owner provided drawings to gain a general familiarity with the construction and maintenance of all areas within the scope. We will also review the current design standards of the Shelby County School System to ensure they are incorporated into the design. Additionally, we will coordinate with the SCS to determine the extent of remediation for mold and asbestos. An environmental report should be made available by SCS reflecting the scope of remediation.

Contract Documents (CD)

AP Architects will provide construction drawings and the technical specifications for the project manual. All scaled construction drawings will be prepared using Revit format consisting of plans, sections, and details depicting typical and atypical conditions to fully describe the intended scope of work.

Our documents will include the following:

- A. Demolition plans
- B. Floor Plans
- C. Finished Plans
- D. Construction details
- E. Sections
- F. General notes
- G. Specifications
- H. Mechanical Drawings
- I. Electrical Drawings

Bidding Phase (BP)

Aaron Patrick Architects will oversee the bidding phase for the aforementioned project.

- A. Aaron Patrick Architects will assist Shelby County Schools in obtaining bids to construct the work from experienced Contractors and respond to questions during the bidding phase.
- B. APA will coordinate distribution of all construction documents to all prospective bidders.
- C. APA will conduct a Pre-bid Conference to provide a project overview as well as answer any questions pertaining to the project.
- D. APA will respond to all questions through formal addenda responses.
- E. APA will assist Shelby County Schools in executing a construction contract between SCS and the awarded Contractor.

Construction Administration (CA)

- A. APA will provide onsite guidance during the course of construction and will address all related RFIs, shop drawing submittals, and pay applications from the contractor. We will also have periodic OAC meetings to continue communication and coordination between the architect, owner, and contractor.
- B. APA will provide periodic field reports documenting the work that in underway and completed. We will also document any deficiencies and promptly report this information in our OAC meetings.
- C. APA will provide a punch list walkthrough at substantial completion and document all outstanding items that are incomplete or defective.
- D. APA will facilitate providing all closeout documentation at final completion.

III. Exclusions from our Basic Scope of Services

Services not set forth above as Basic Scope of Services in this proposal are excluded from the scope of our work and we assume no responsibility to perform such services, including but not limited to:

- **A.** Services required due to changes in the agreed upon scope including changes to size, complexity, time, etc.
- **B.** Building Commissioning Services
- **C.** Construction Cost Estimating

IV. Compensation: Our proposed compensation for the above basic scope of services is as followed: Stipulated Sum **\$185,000** (One hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars

00/100 cents) *Based on \$2,250,000 construction cost

The fee includes the basic scope of services as listed above. This fee excludes all reimbursable expenses that are incurred by the Architect. We will submit invoices monthly based on the percentage of project completion. The breakdown of the fee is as follow:

An inspection was conducted at 2086 Young Avenue (Peabody Elementary School), to investigate complaint number 2075372. The following are the results from the inspection:

 The building has mold in all of the vents. It is visible to everyone. 	AMG in the lower floors: Our team walked the halls of the school and noticed extreme humidity in rooms 111 and 120. We placed a dehumidifier in room 111 but AMG is reoccurring. The AMG team will clean up any reoccurring mold. The plan is to have the vendor that came out last week, come back out to address the system that is causing the moister and to address the drainage which is also a major problem. We will add an additional dehumidifier in room 120 until these HVAC concerns are addressed.
2. There is no working intercom system, which is how employees are alerted for lockdowns and other emergencies. If employees were in an active shooter situation, they would all be at risk. There have been lockdown incidents but there is no way for the classrooms to know so employees have not gone into lockdown while the rest of the school has. No system has been put in place to update safety precautions.	Intercom: The techs made an assessment of the intercom system and suggested replacing a station card for the Bogen intercom. We ordered the Bogen station card and the station card was implemented. The tech then discovered that additional work needed to be done on the back plain where everything is connected. A vendor with more experience with Bogen intercom systems will be contracted to perform this work. State Systems, which is the vendor of choice, will repair the system's back plain. Once State System has completed their work we will conduct a follow up.
 There is no working fire alarm, so if there is a fire, the employees are at risk. There was a fire drill yesterday and no one on the floor even knew that they were supposed to exit the building. 	A work order (1010289) has been requested from our fire alarm vendor (Siemens). The FA system is still being monitored and will still dispatch the MFD. Siemens has found the issue and has ordered the part for the system repairs.

On August 30, 2023, the Tennessee Occupational Safety and Health Administration (TOSHA) received a complaint concerning hazards at Peabody Elementary School located at 2086 Young Ave in MEMPHIS, Tennessee. The specific nature of the complaint involves the following:

1. The building has mold in all of the vents. It is visible to everyone.

2. There is no working fire alarm, so if there is a fire, the employees are at risk. There was a fire drill yesterday and no one on the floor even knew that they were supposed to exit the building.

3. There is no working intercom system, which is how employees are alerted for lockdowns and other emergencies. If employees were in an active shooter situation, they would all be at risk. There have been lockdown incidents but there is no way for the classrooms to know so employees have not gone into lockdown while the rest of the school has. No system has been put in place to update safety precautions.

We have not determined whether the hazards, as alleged, exist at your workplace; and we are not conducting an inspection at this time. However, since allegations of violations have been made, you should investigate the alleged conditions and make any necessary corrections or modifications. Within (five) 5 working days or less of your receipt of this letter, please advise us in writing of your findings and of the action you have taken. Your response should be detailed, stating specifically what action you have taken to correct any hazards. You should enclose any supporting documentation on the action you have taken, such as monitoring results, new equipment, purchase orders, as well as photographs of the corrected condition. Please send your response to Kevin Duke via email at Kevin.Duke@tn.gov, or via mail to 220 French Landing Drive, Nashville, TN 37243.

This letter is not a citation nor is it a notification of proposed penalty which, according to the Tennessee Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1972, as amended, may be issued only after an inspection or investigation of the workplace. If we do not receive a response from you within 5 working days indicating that appropriate action has been taken or that no hazard exists and why, an inspection may be conducted. In addition, to assure that the employer has taken the corrective action asserted in the response, random inspections are periodically conducted.

Finally, any action taken by you in this matter will not automatically remove your workplace from the possibility of an unannounced inspection by duly authorized representatives of TOSHA in accordance with routine scheduling procedures currently in effect.

You are requested to post a copy of this letter and your responses to it where it will be readily accessible for review by all your employees.
